SCHOOL UNIFORM AND SCHOOL CLOTHING

The Edinburgh Police Fund for Children (EPFC)

The Edinburgh Police Fund for Children (EPFC) (previously known as the Police Aided Clothing Scheme (PACS)) provides assistance with purchase of **school footwear and school jackets**. Grants are normally up to £50 per child. Applications are generally made online and families are usually referred by a third party including Health Visitor, Head Teacher, Education Welfare Officer or Third Sector worker. Where a family self refers, a home visit assessment will be carried out by a Police Officer.

Families must be resident in the City of Edinburgh

The fund is administered by Edinburgh and Lothian Trust Fund.
